The Book Club meets monthly from November to April. The gathering is held in the BBC Meeting Room (building D) at 9:30 am for breakfast and the book discussion.



by Taylor Jenkins Reid



by Benjamin Stevenson


A deviously clever novella featuring Ernest Cunningham as a well-known detective. Merry Christmas!!!!

A breathtaking love story where flawed characters try desperately to survive against the odds.




Tuesday, February 10, 2026




Tuesday, March 10, 2026
